- 1) For the **first** and **second** false alarm in any twelve month period, a warning shall be issued
- 2) For the **third** false alarm in any twelve month period a fine of twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) shall be paid to the township.
- 3) For the **fourth** or any subsequent false alarms in such twelve month period a fine of fifty dollars (\$50.00) shall be paid to the township.

An Alarm Permit Application is required to be completed and filed every year with our department. This application is required in order to accurately maintain our records as indicated in Township Ordinance 92-4 which requires: "Any person, firm or corporation that owns or operates an alarm device or a local alarm shall make application for the installation, operation and continuance thereof, in writing, to the Chief of Police on the form provided by the Police Department." The ordinance requires registration of an alarm system within thirty (30) days of installation and renewal every year. Violation of this ordinance provides for a fine not exceeding one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00).
