ZONE 1

1st Collection Week of November 14th 2nd Collection Week of December 12th

Zone 1 includes RT.38 and all streets north of RT. 38 Hollybrook and Glenwood Section, RT 541 (Main ST. from RT.38 south to Pershing Avenue.) Beulah Ave., Eastlick Ave., Ellis Ave., Harding Ave., Pershing Ave., Roosevett Ave., and Wilson Ave.

ZONE 2

1st Collection Week of November 21th 2nd Collection Week of December 19th

Zone 2 includes Maple Grove Estates, all sections of Bobby's Run Municipal Dr., RT. 541 (Main St. from south of Pershing Ave. to municipal Dr.) Chambers St., Chestnut St., Eayestown Rd. (from Rt.38 to Municipal Dr.) Green St., Moore St., Morris St., Pear St., Queen St., Ridgway St., Ross St., Second St., Spruce St., Landing St., Walnut St.

ZONE 3

1st Collection Week of November 28th 2nd Collection Week of December 26th

Zone 3 includes County Village, Waverly and Stirling Chase, RT. 541 (Main St. from Municipal Dr to Medford Twp.Line) Ark Rd., Bella Rd., Bridge Rd., Camp Dr., Church St., Country Club Dr., Country Way, Creek Rd., Crispin Rd., Eayestown Rd., (from Municipal Dr. to the Medford Twp line), Edward St., Evergreen St., Fenimore Rd., Fostertown Rd., Fox Run, Githens Lane, Hopewell Ave., Landing St., Marriott Dr., Newbolds Corner Rd., Patricia Court, Pheasant Lane, Point St., Quail Hollow Lane, Deer Path, Shawn's Way, Stacy Haines Rd., and Willow

To Help the Department of Public Works do their job efficiently, please remember to use extreme care to ensure that there is no foreign debris such as, tree limbs, rocks, bottles, etc. In the leaves. These items can cause costly breakdowns of the machine and delays in the pick up schedule.

Ideally, it is recommended that a fenced- in holding pen or similar means of containment be devised to prevent leaves from blowing after they are raked. Residents should be aware that the leaves <u>must</u> be raked to the curb in order for the vacuum hose to reach them.

To ease the collection process and reduce the risk of fire from automotive exhaust systems, residents are urged not to park vehicles in the area near the raked leaves that are placed in the street.
