

**TOWNSHIP OF LUMBERTON**

**ORDINANCE 2005-21**

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 162 OF THE  
CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF LUMBERTON  
ENTITLED, “GARBAGE, RUBBISH AND REFUSE”, AND SPECIFICALLY TO  
AMEND SECTION 162-2 ESTABLISHING THE REMOVAL OF WASTE REQUIRED;  
REGULATIONS FOR THE TOWNSHIP OF LUMBERTON**

**BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED** by the Township Committee of the Township of Lumberton, County of Burlington, State of New Jersey as follows:

**AMENDED SECTIONS.**

A. Section 162-2C5 of the **Code of the Township of Lumberton**, the text contained in Chapter 162, which Section is entitled “Removal by township”, is hereby deleted and replaced as follows:

“Brush resulting from normal property maintenance or storm damage will be collected by township that is less than ten (10) inches in diameter. Brush resulting from lot clearing for any purpose or that is generated by a contractor hired by the owner shall be the responsibility of the property owner.”

A. Section 162-2D1 of the **Code of the Township of Lumberton**, the text contained in Chapter 162, which Section is entitled “Items not removed by the township”, is hereby deleted and replaced as follows:

“Asphalt pavement, branches and brush over ten (10) inches in diameter, block, brick, concrete, decks, fences, masonry, roof shingles, sheds, sod, and oversized tires by nature of their weight and size will not be picked up or disposed of by the township. The property owner shall make arrangements with a private company for their disposal”

**ARTICLE II. REPEALER, SEVERABILITY AND EFFECTIVE DATE.**

- A. Repealer. Any and all Ordinances inconsistent with the terms of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of any such inconsistencies.
- B. Severability. In the event that any clause, section, paragraph or sentence of this Ordinance is deemed to be invalid or unenforceable for any reason, then the Township Committee hereby declares its intent that the balance of the Ordinance not affected by said invalidity shall remain in full force and

effect to the extent that it allows the Township to meet the goals of the Ordinance.

- C. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall take effect upon proper passage in accordance with the law.
