

**TOWNSHIP OF LUMBERTON
RESOLUTION 2015-01-037**

**AUTHORIZING THE DISPOSAL OF POLICE VESTS TO THE
BURLINGTON COUNTY SPCA UNDER CERTAIN CONDITIONS**

WHEREAS, the Lumberton Police Department requires its officers to wear body armor vest as protection against nefarious activity; and

WHEREAS, the vest worn by the law enforcement officers have a five year life span before they are replaced by the Township or, when funds are made available, through the State's Body Armor Replacement Fund; and

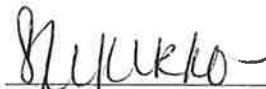
WHEREAS, the Chief of Police has received a request from the local Society for the Prevention of Animal Cruelty to receive vests which are being removed from law enforcement service; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:11-36, the Township may dispose of Township owned property through a resolution to other agencies performing government or quasi-government functions; and

WHEREAS, the Burlington County SPCA performs such a function by enforcing animal welfare laws

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Township Committee of the Township of Lumberton, County of Burlington, State of New Jersey, that the Township of Lumberton hereby donates thirteen (13) body armor vest to the Burlington County Society for the Prevention of Animal Cruelty in "as-is" condition with no guarantees or warranties, express or implied, as to the fitness for the particular intended purpose of the vests and on the understanding and commitment from the BCSPCA that it will forever indemnify and hold harmless the Township of Lumberton in the event of injury, severe or otherwise, including, but not limited to, fatalities that result from the use of these donated items.
