A RESOLUTION ENDORSING THE SUBMISSION OF
A RECYCLING TONNAGE GRANT APPLICATION TO THE
NEW JERSEY DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION
AND APPOINTING STEPHANIE YURKO TO ENSURE THE
THE FILING WITH A CERTIFIED RECYLCING PROFESSIONAL

WHEREAS, the Mandatory Source Separation and Recycling Act, P.L. 1987, c. 102, has established a recycling fund from which tonnage grant may be made to municipalities in order to encourage local source separation and recycling programs; and

WHEREAS, it is the intent and the spirit of the Mandatory Source Separation and Recycling Act to use the tonnage grants to develop new municipal recycling programs and to continue and to expand existing programs; and

WHEREAS, the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection is promulgating recycling regulations to implement the Mandatory Source Separation and Recycling Act; and

WHEREAS, the recycling regulations impose on municipalities certain requirements as a condition for applying for tonnage grants, including but not limited to, making and keeping accurate, verifiable records of materials collected and claimed by the municipal; and

WHEREAS, a resolution authorizing Lumberton Township to apply for such tonnage grants for the year 2014 will memorialize the commitment of this municipality to recycling and to indicate the assent of the Township Committee of Lumberton Township to the efforts undertaken by Lumberton Township and the requirements contained in the Recycling Act and recycling regulations; and

WHEREAS, such a resolution should designate the individual authorized to ensure the application is properly completed and timely filed.

NOW THEREFORE BY IT RESOLVED by the Township Committee of Lumberton Township that Lumberton hereby endorses the submission of the recycling tonnage grant application to the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection and designates Stephanie Yurko to ensure that the application is properly filed along with a CRP;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the monies received from the recycling tonnage grant be deposited in a dedicated recycling trust fund to be used solely for the purposes of recycling.
