RESOLUTION 2016-161

AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF ADDENDA WITH PROPERTY OWNERS FOR THE FEMA FLOOD MITIGATION PROJECT

WHEREAS, the property owners at Block 27, Lot 2; Block 17.02; Lot 4 and Block 21 Lot 23.03 ("Property Owners") suffered severe damage during flooding events causing the Federal Emergency Management Agency to provide grant incentives to raise the structures on the property above flood elevation levels; and

WHEREAS, the Property Owners have executed contracts with a lift contractor and general contractor to perform the necessary work; and

WHEREAS, the Property Owners are eligible for reimbursement of seventy-five percent of the cost with a total grant amount of \$640,250; and

WHEREAS, the Property Owners reimbursement must be passed through the municipality as a term of the grant; and

WHEREAS, the Property Owners originally signed an agreement with the Township for payment of this project and an addendum is necessary to develop the procedure for reimbursement;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Township Committee of the Township of Lumberton, County of Burlington, State of New Jersey that the Mayor, Administrator and Municipal Clerk are authorized to execute an Addendum to the Contract with the Property Owners of the above listed Blocks and Lots to establish a reimbursement procedure consistent with this resolution and the underlying contract.


